Speaking Fees

- 1. Local Engagements (within the SF Bay Area, CA) have a minimum speaking fee of \$200/hr.
- **2. Out-of-Town Engagements** have a minimum *total* speaking fee of \$1000.
- 3. Total Expenses include speaking fees, travel expenses, and expenses for any requested materials (workbooks or materials for workshop activities).
- 4. Required Upon Reservation: A 25% deposit and payment for travel expenses.
- 5. Speaking Fees Vary depending on the type of engagement (talk vs. workshop), the number of attendees, the location of the event, date of the event, and the type of special requests made to tailor the talk/workshop.
